Please submit a copy of the applicant's completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

REMINDER: To be eligible for the IT Only Takes 1 Scholarship, applicants must demonstrate financial need by documenting an Expected Family Contribution of \$10,000 or less on their FAFSA or a low to moderate parent adjusted gross income.

Other extenuating financial circumstances may also be considered, provided the applicant includes a brief written explanation with their application materials.

5 Personal Essay

Applicants must submit a brief (300 to 500 words) written essay addressing some of the following questions or prompts:

- Why should you be chosen to receive a cybersecurity scholarship and what makes you stand out from your peers?
- Describe your personal background.
- What or who inspired you to pursue a career in cybersecurity?
- What or who inspired you to serve in the military?
- What attributes do you have that will help you succeed in the information security industry?
- What skills or attributes to you hope to attain through military service?
- What are your goals for your professional career?
- When you graduate and secure a career in cybersecurity, what steps can you take to "pay it forward" and support others looking to work in the field?
- What, if any, contributions have you already made to the cybersecurity field (Examples: volunteer work, hobbies or extracurricular activities, articles, etc.)?

Service for Cyber Scholarship

Terms and Conditions

Service for Cyber Scholarship awards must be spent on tuition, fees, books, supplies and equipment required for coursework in an eligible field of study at an accredited college or university.

Unless otherwise specified, scholarship recipients can recieve awards for a maximum of eight (8) semesters (four academic years).

To remain eligible for subsequent award payments, scholarship recipients must be enrolled full-time (12 university credit hours or the equivalent in a professional certification program) and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Prior to the release of any award payment, recipients must provide written proof of enrollment in an eligible program. Proof of enrollment must be sent directly to AZ Cyber Initiative from the institution and document the following:

- Enrollment in the fall semester of the application year
- Acceptance and in enrollment in ROTC or equivalent program
- · Number of credits for which student is enrolled
- Program of study
- Student's current cumulative GPA

Award payments will be made by check and sent on the recipient's behalf to the institution where they are enrolled.
